gonna spread God's love around. (Cross arms over chest and spin around.)

When I love my sister, (use fingers to make a heart shape) I'm loving Jesus,

If I'm **following** Jesus (march in place) when I **love** my sister, (use fingers to make a heart shape)

gonna spread God's **love around**. (Cross arms over chest and spin around.)

When I **live my life**, **my life** for Jesus, (begin with both hands over heart and then raise hands in praise) and I spread God's love around (oh, yeah).
