# **Teaching Aids**

**SESSION 1** 

**Letter to Families** 

#### **Dear Families**,

We are so thankful to spend this time with your children. Over the next 13 weeks, children will hear parables of Jesus, engage with the events of Holy Week, and learn some important lessons sent to early followers of Jesus. We invite you to read together, pray together, and write together as a family. See some specific ideas below to engage in these themes together.

#### **Read Together!**

The first four sessions of this quarter focus on parables, or stories, told by Jesus. Spend time together as a family reading some of your favorite children's books and Bible stories. Parents can also tell stories from their childhood to their children. Talk about any lessons that you can learn as a family from each story you read or hear together.

#### **Pray Together!**

During Lent, the children will sense many different emotions, from the high of Palm Sunday, to the low of Jesus' final meal with friends leading to his death on the cross, to the confusing high that Jesus is alive on Easter! Children will pray about the "mountains" and "valleys" in their lives for several sessions. Pray together as a family in the same way. Take turns talking about the highs and lows of life. What are the positive and negative moments from your past week? Offer them to God in prayer.


#### Write Together!

The final five sessions of this quarter will teach children about important messages to the early churches in letters sent by Paul and John. Work together to write letters and send them in the mail to family and friends. Even just a note to remind people that they are loved by God can make a huge difference.




## SESSION 7 Story Images

Copy and cut apart to use at the story stations during Explore (Retell). Each child will need one copy of each image to glue on booklet page 7B.




#### SESSION 7 Story Station Labels

Cut these labels apart and set in four different areas with the matching Story Images during Explore (Retell).



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
